WELL CHILD POLICY

Because we desire to protect children and volunteers from exposure to illness; the following symptoms will determine if a child should not be admitted to our classrooms:

- Fever (over 99°- child must be fever free for 24 straight hours from recent illness)
- Persistent coughing and/or sneezing
- Any discolored nasal discharge
- Vomiting
- Inflamed throat
- Earache
- Diarrhea
- Runny nose and/or eyes
- Unusual fatigue and irritability
- Complaints of stomachache
- Swollen glands
- Rash (except diaper rash)

If a child shows signs of any of these symptoms while in our care, we will contact the parent or guardian immediately. We understand that children with allergies or who are teething may exhibit some these symptoms and exceptions will be made.
